The case of V.I. Lenin in the activities of workers of culture and art of the Ulyanovsk, Samara, Penza regions at the turn of the 1980s of the XX century

It is considered the implementation of the policy of the Soviet Union in the mid-80s of the XX century on the basis of state archival data, presented social and cultural events organized by employees of club institutions during the activities of the Soviets of People's Deputies to promote one idea — the idea dedicated to the "Lenin case".
