

Philosophy of Russian history in the views of the Eurasians

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The appearance in Russia in the early XX century the state, which had been based on qualitatively new principles of political and social order, forced the representatives emigrated from its intellectual strata of society, to undertake a thorough analysis of the mission of Russia in the world and the place of Bolshevism. Among some of the spiritual elite emigration has shaped the ideological trend known as Eurasianism. Because of their cultural traditions and geographical position, Russia, in the opinion of the Eurasians, becomes the main obstacle to universal Europeanization and Westernization of the world. In connection with this understanding of the place and role of Russia in the world Eurasians faced the task of radically revising its entire history, compared to how it was presented in a Europeanized Russian historical science.
